The Australian Breastfeeding Association (ABA) is a voluntary organisation established in 1964 (as the Nursing Mothers' Association of Australia), to encourage and support mothers who wish to breastfeed their babies and to promote skilled and loving mothering, while creating in the community an awareness of the importance of human milk.

Breastfeeding Help

Throughout Australia, the Australian Breastfeeding Association's trained breastfeeding counsellors provide free counselling and breastfeeding information to any person seeking help. All our volunteer counsellors have undergone extensive training with the Australian Breastfeeding Association. As mothers who have breastfed their own children, they know breastfeeding may not always be easy, but with access to accurate information and experience they can provide you with the support, reassurance and knowledge you need.

All counsellors are bound by a Code of Ethics and offer their support over the phone, in person at our meetings and through a wide range of literature.

The Australian Breastfeeding Association is a non-profit organisation and we rely on grants, donations and membership subscriptions to continue our work in the community.
